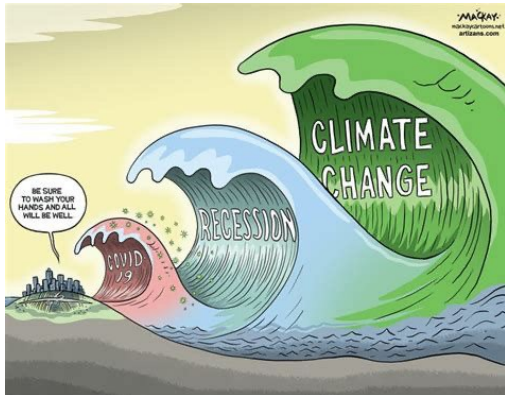


SCC-LG group /SCALE Event

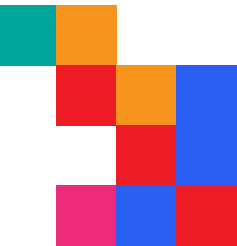
The SCC-LG and beyond are all welcomed to join in all sessions.

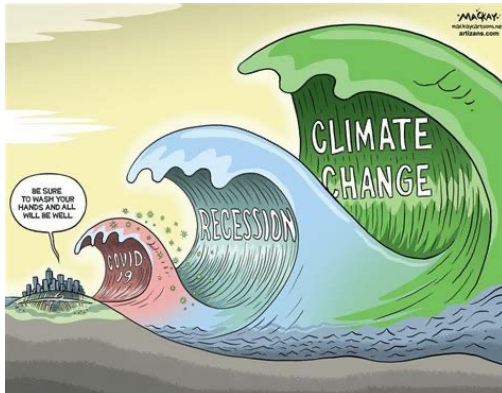

- **Mehdi Coly**, founder of Time for the Planet



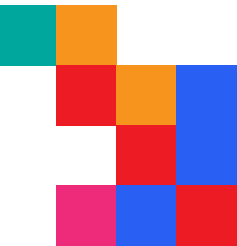
To deepen this debate, four studios will be physically held by the “Four” SCC-2016 projects. They will look at four themes that will make the future of cities:

4. Smart districts



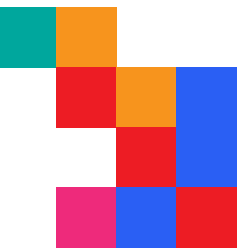
With the help of a panel of experts, the “Four” will the business, organisational and technological models to reach their desirable futures. A web-conference will be set up in order for all to join the discussion.

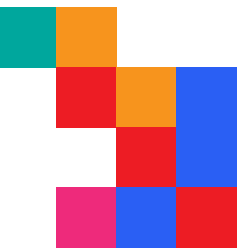
