The SmartEnCity Network

Chortkiv is a city of regional importance located in the Ternopil region of Ukraine. It is located in the western part of Ukraine with a population of 29,000 people.

As of 30. March 2016, the city of Chortkiv is a signatory of the Mayor-East Agreement and has committed itself to reduce CO₂ emissions by at least 40% by 2030 by implementing:

- energy-saving measures
- expanding the use of renewable energy

In order to achieve this goal, a draft Sustainable Energy Development and Climate Action Plan for the city of Chortkiv by 2030 has been developed and approved and has been successfully implemented during last four years. This strategic document envisages:

- energy efficiency measures in budgetary institutions and institutions;
- residential buildings;
- public transport;
- municipal public lighting;
- municipal utilities.

SmartEnCity and BIM Speed join forces in Coronacion demo district



Coronación Demo District in Vitoria Gasteiz is harnessing European resources to become more sustainable and to enhance quality of life for its' citizens. Two European projects SmartEnCity and BIM Speed are sharing two buildings from the demo district as case studies in two complementary approaches that may serve to fulfil both projects' main objectives while providing the tenants with a higher comfort with cutting edge technologies applied in renovation.

The two buildings, built in 1958, are located in the Lighthouse City of [Vitoria-Gasteiz](#). Both buildings are without insulation, they have a poor energy performance with condensation and humidity problems. [Read full article.](#)

Art season in Lighthouse City Tartu has paused for the winter



Within the SmartEnCity framework, the last two wall paintings in Tartu's smart city district were completed in September 2019, with the remaining paintings set to be completed in 2020. A total of 12 paintings were created in Tartu's smart city district in 2018 and 2019, created by artists from Estonia, Latvia, Poland and Argentina. The art-creation work will continue when warm weather returns in spring 2020, with ambitions to create at least four new artworks in the City Centre of Tartu. When the SmartEnCity project ends, the smart city district will be decorated with a unique public art gallery.
