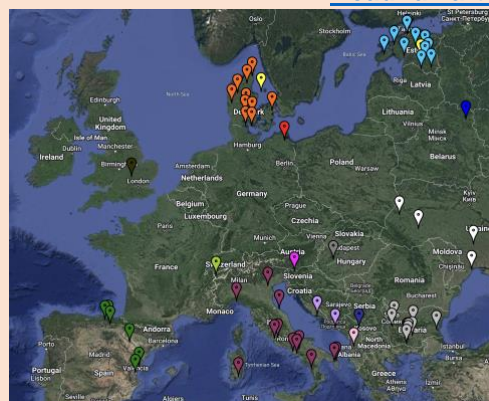
The Spanish Network is rapidly growing and on top of that they are planning their first meeting in May 2022.
